



Liechtenstein Open International Amateur Championship 2026

Ladies & Men

August, 21st– 23rd

The Principality of Liechtenstein is located in the border triangle of Switzerland, Austria and Germany. This year, we have decided to play the Liechtenstein Open Amateur Championship (men and ladies) on our home course GC Gams-Werdenberg over 54 holes. This tournament is a WAGR ranked event and certainly unique in the EGA tournament calendar.

Schedule	54 holes of stroke play (3 rounds) men & ladies from Champions Tees
Friday	21 st August, 1 st Round GC Gams-Werdenberg
Saturday	22 nd August, 2 nd Round GC Gams-Werdenberg
Sunday	23 rd August, 3 rd Round GC Gams-Werdenberg

Conditions The Championship is open to male and female amateur golfers as defined by the current Rules of Amateur Status. All competitors must be members of a golf club or a golf organization which itself is a member of its national federation / association.

Eligibility Entry is limited to 60 competitors (39 men and 21 ladies)
The handicap limit is 9.9 or better for men, 15.0 for ladies, certified by the respective handicap authority and must be validated on the date of entry. If the number of entries exceeds 60, places in the starting field will be decided by the Handicap ballot. Accepted entries and reserve lists will be published on our website.
Exemptions:
The following will be exempt from the ballot provided they satisfy the handicap requirements: Six (6) players as nominated by the Liechtenstein Golf Association.



Ties

In case of a tie for 1st place, the winner shall be determined by sudden death play-off on at beforehand announced holes. For any further tie, the winners will be decided based on the final stipulated 36, 18, 9, 6, 3 holes or last hole, in that order.

Rules

The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by R&A, the Liechtenstein Golf Association 'Hard Card', the General Conditions of Competition, with the Local Rules approved by the Championship Committee.

Registration

All entries have to be submitted online on the Liechtenstein Golf Association's website must register via the official website of the Liechtenstein Golf Association (www.golf.li/turniere).

Foreign players who are not yet registered on (PC Caddie) can register via following link (www.golf.li/turniere/liechtenstein-open/)

Liechtenstein Golf Association must receive fully completed entry form until **Friday, August 14th, 2026, no later than 6 p.m.** Entry Fees must be transferred before Wednesday, August 19th 2026.

A competitor who does not register up to this time and or did not pay the entry fee in time, is liable to be withdrawn from the championship.

Entry Fee:

• Men's	220.- EUR	200.- CHF
• Ladies	220.- EUR	200.- CHF
• Boys*	110.- EUR	100.- CHF
• Girls*	110.- EUR	100.- CHF

*(Juniors U21, 21 years of age or younger in the year of the championship, born in 2005 and younger)



In case a player does not pay the fee, he/she will be not allowed to compete. Entry Fee includes: Green Fees, water & snacks every day of competition, Drinks and Buffet after Prize giving ceremony.
